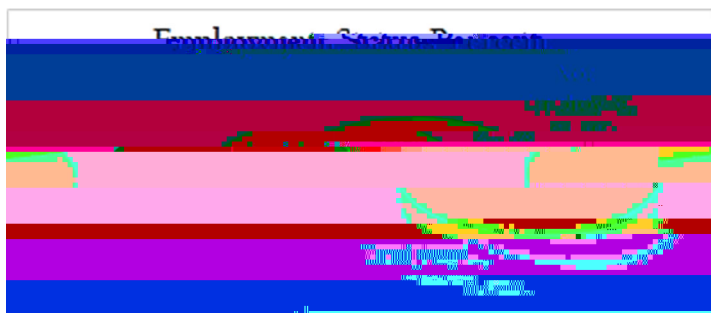


2020-21 Traditional Undergraduate First Destination Survey Report Concordia University Wisconsin

- € 95.2% of graduates are employed or attending graduate school (Previous year 93.2%)
- € 78.9% of graduates employed. (Previous year 82.7%).
- € 88.2% of those employed are employed full time. 70% of all reporting graduates are employed full time.
- € 36.1% of graduates attending graduate school. (Previous year 21.8%)
- € 65.3% of all students surveyed participated in an internship, clinical, practicum, or field placement.
- € 75.0% of those employed are employed in their major field of study.
- € \$44,960 average reported salary of full time employed graduates.

Response Rate: 36.1%, 147 responses of 407 graduates. (Previous Year 31.7%)

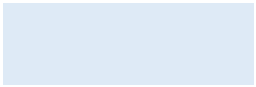
